



Stampin' Up! Saint Nicholas Stamp Set and Traditions of St. Nick DSP Slimline Card

Cutting Instructions:

Basic White

8" x 3" (2 pieces)

Cherry Cobbler

8-1/2" x 7" scored at 3-1/2" on the 7" side for cardbase

3" x 2" for sentiment banner

Mossy Meadow

8-1/4" x 3-1/4" (2 pieces)

3/8" x 7-3/4"

Traditions of St. Nick DSP

Ornate Green – 6" x 3"

White with holly – 4-1/4" x 2-1/4"

Red Ornate 3-1/4" x 1-1/2"

10" x 1-3/4" for envelope flap

Instructions

1. Select three pieces of the Traditions of St. Nick DSP to use for your circles. I suggest two darks and a light.
2. Using the Stylish Shapes dies and the Stampin' Cut and Emboss machine, cut two large circles from a dark color, two medium circles from the lightest color and two small circles from the medium color.
3. Emboss a Mossy Meadow panel with the Christmas Tidings 3D Embossing Folder. The panel is longer than the folder, so emboss what you can, then turn the folder and place the remaining part of the panel in the folder and run through the Stampin' Cut and Emboss machine again.
4. Cut each circle in half using scissors or a paper trimmer.
5. Glue the three pieces of the first half circle to the right side of the circle with the largest on the bottom, the medium in the middle and the small on the top.
6. With the other half of each piece, turn them so the cut side is on the top and adhere the medium and small pieces on the left side of the bottom circle. Repeat step 4 and 5 with the remaining two sets of half circles.
7. Arrange the half circles on the basic white layer as shown in the photo leaving a gap between the circles down the middle of the card. You will offset each circle and line up with the same colors to create a flowing effect.
8. Adhere the half circles to the card with liquid glue.
9. Cut a 9" piece of White 1/2" iridescent ribbon and place it down the center of the card, covering the gap. If desired, use mini glue dots to hold the ribbon to the card.
10. Put Stampin' Seal on the back of the card. Wrap the ribbon around the panel edge and adhere the ribbon to the back of the panel.
11. Glue the 3/8" x 7-3/4" strip of Mossy Meadow to the ribbon down the center of the card.
12. Adhere the Basic White panel to the embossed Mossy Meadow panel with liquid glue.
13. Cut the 2nd largest banner from the Nested Essentials dies from Cherry Cobbler.
14. Swipe the embossing buddy over the Cherry Cobbler.
15. Stamp the sentiment with Versamark.
16. Hold the banner over the Powder Pal and sprinkle the white embossing powder on the cardstock, covering the stamped sentiment.
17. Shake and/or tap off any excess embossing powder into the Powder Pal. Use the craft brush, if needed, to remove excess powder.
18. Warm your heat tool on high. Hold the banner with the reverse tweezers and heat the embossing powder until it melts. Allow to cool.
19. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment banner to the center of the basic white layer.
20. Place 3-5 Adhesive-Backed Glitter Sequins to the front panel of the card.
21. Adhere the basic white panel to the Embossed Mossy Meadow panel with liquid glue.
22. With Stampin' Dimensionals, adhere the front panel to the front of the card.
23. For the inside layer, stamp the sentiment in Cherry Cobbler in the upper center of the card.

24. Stamp the snack trio (Gingerbread, beverage and candy cane) in Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
25. Color the gingerbread in light Crumb Cake Stampin' Blends.
26. Color the stripes of the candy cane with light Cherry Cobbler Stampin' Blends.
27. Color the drink portion of the beverage with light Wild Wheat.
28. Color the drink citrus with both light and dark Lemon Lolly.
29. Adhere the basic white inside layer to the Mossy Meadow inside mat with Stampin' Seal.
30. With liquid glue, adhere the matted inside layer to the card base.
31. With liquid glue, adhere the DSP to the envelope flap and trim with paper snips.
32. Stamp the mailbox on the front of the envelope in Cherry Cobbler.
