



Stampin' Up!® Planted Paradise Any Occasion Card

Cutting Instructions:

Basic White

- 5-1/4" x 4" for inside layer
- 5-1/2 X 8-1/2 for circle die cuts
- 3" x 10" for leaves stamping
- 1-1/2" x 3" for planter stamping

- Basic White – Thick 5-1/2 X 8-1/2 scored at 4-1/4" for card base

Old Olive

- 5-3/8" x 4-1/8" for inside mat

Instructions

1. Use the seven smallest Deckled Circle dies and the Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine to cut seven circles.
2. Emboss the circles with the Layered Floral 3D Embossing Folder (available in the Jan – Apr 2024 Mini Catalog).
3. Arrange deckled circles on the front of the card base in any arrangement pleasing to you.
4. Adhere circles to the card base with liquid glue. Some circle edges may hang off the edges and can be trimmed with paper snips.
5. Ink the large planter with Pretty Peacock ink and stamp off twice before stamping on Basic White card stock.
6. Place the three leaves in a pattern on a Clear Block D with the flat side to on the block.
7. Stamp the three set of leaves full strength in all three colors (clean the stamps between colors) – Old Olive, Granny Apple Green and Mossy Meadow.
8. After cleaning the detailed stamps, take them off the block and line them up flat side down in the same arrangement as you just stamped. Place the Clear Block D on the stamps to pick them up.
9. Stamp three set of leaves again with in all three inks, but this time stamp off twice before stamping the reverse image.
10. Cut the 9 leaf images and one planter image using paper snips.
11. Arrange the leaves in the pot with the three leafed plant in the middle and the longer leaves arranged on the side and behind the three leafed plant.
12. Adhere the plant and leaves to the planter with liquid glue.
13. Place several dimensionals on the back of the planter and plants making sure you have supported the leaf edges, center and base of the planter.
14. Adhere the focal point to the card front.
15. Add three gold Blooming Pearls embellishments to the front of the card.
16. For the inside of the card, stamp a planter detail in Pretty Peacock full strength and a reverse planter in Pretty Peacock, stamped off twice.
17. Use a piece of paper or a sticky note to cover the planter before stamping the detailed three leaf plant in full strength Old Olive.
18. Reverse the three leaf plant and stamp over the detail with Old Olive stamped off twice.
19. Adhere the Basic White inside layer to the Old Olive mat with Stampin' Seal.
20. Adhere the mat to the card base with liquid glue.
21. Stamp three pots on the envelope flap in full strength Granny Apple Green ink.

22. Reverse the planter and with Granny Apple Green stamped off twice, stamp the planter over the detailed image.
23. Using a sticky note to cover the planter edge, stamp the three leaf plant detailed image with Mossy Meadow in each planter.
24. Leaving the sticky note covering the planter, reverse the plant stamp and stamp the reverse image in Mossy Meadow stamped off twice.
25. For the front of the envelope, select the rounded planter and stamp the detailed image in Pretty Peacock full strength.
26. Clean the stamp and reverse it. Then, in Pretty Peacock, stamp off twice and stamp over the detailed image.
27. Cover the edge of the planter with a sticky note.
28. Stamp three detailed leaf images in Granny Apple Green.
29. Clean and reverse the stamp, lining up with the detail stamp and press onto the Clear Block D.
30. Ink the stamps with Granny Apple Green, stamp off once on a sticky note (this will become a mask) and then a second time on scrap paper. Stamp over the detailed image.
31. Cut out the leaf image mask and place it over the three leaves on the envelope.
32. With the rounded (I'm guessing eucalyptus leaves??), stamp over the other leaves in Mossy Meadow ink, stamped off twice.
