



Sea Turtle Stamp Set and Courage & Faith Collage Card

Cutting Instructions:

Coordinating DSP

6" x 2-1/4" for envelope flap

Basic White

4" x 5-1/4" (2 pcs) front panel & inside panel

Scraps for die cutting

Night of Navy

4-1/8" x 5-3/8" front mat

Coastal Cabana

5-1/2" x 8-1/2" for cardbase

Instructions

1. Fold card base at score lines and burnish with a bone folder.
2. **As you are doing your stamping, you want to keep in mind vertical and horizontal lines intersecting through the turtle.
3. On one of the Basic White panels, stamp the large turtle in Tuxedo Black Memento ink offset from the upper left corner.
4. Stamp the same turtle on a piece of Stampin' Up! Masking Paper and fussy cut the turtle with paper snips.
5. Remove the masking paper backing and apply the mask over the turtle, covering it entirely.
6. Stamp the small turtles in full strength Night of Navy ink three times around the card base.
7. Stamp some partial small turtles in Night of Navy stamped off once, then do not reink.

8. Use a blending brush to blend Night of Navy ink lightly over the stamped images. Add just enough to add some color, without overwhelming the small turtles.
9. With the Sea Turtle Stamp Set long bubbles, stamp vertically (up and down) in Coastal Cabana, stamped off once, stamping over the masked turtle.
10. With the long bubbles again, stamp a horizontal (left and right) image in Coastal Cabana stamped off once. Again, you want to stamp over the masked turtle intersecting with the vertical stamp.
11. Use a blending brush to add Coastal Cabana ink over the masked turtle, concentrating ink around the turtle edges.
12. Stamp the small fish stamp randomly a few times in Coastal Cabana stamped off twice – you want a suggestion of fish. Stamping over the turtle is encouraged.
13. Stamp the large starfish stamp several times in Calypso Coral ink. Remember to stamp over the masked turtle.
14. Blend Calypso Coral ink with a blending brush over your stamped images lightly.
15. Use the Courage & Faith dotted texture stamp to add Night of Navy dots over the turtle and sparingly around the card – ink once, then stamp several times.
16. Add a drop of Tuxedo Black Memento ink to a clear D block.
17. Using a water painter, squeeze and add one drop of water to the ink and mix with the water painter.
18. Tap the water painter over the card to create black spatter drops. Allow to dry before continuing to the next step (it doesn't take long).
19. Remove the mask from the large turtle.
20. Stamp the Courage & Faith sentiment on Basic White paper in Calypso Coral ink.
21. Use the second largest Tailor Made Tags and tie cut the sentiment.
22. Stamp the upper left and lower right edges of the tag with the bubble stamp and Coastal Cabana ink.
23. Thread a length of Night of Navy & Gold Glittered Ribbon through the tag opening. The length depends on how long you want your tails.
24. Use white Baker's Twine and tie a bow around the Night of Navy & Gold Glittered Ribbon to secure the ribbon.
25. Trim your Night of Navy & Gold ribbon tails on a diagonal.
26. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the tag and adhere to the front of the card.
27. Add three (3 – one large, two small) gold Blooming Pearls to the card panel.
28. Adhere the front panel to the Night of Navy base with liquid glue.
29. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the matted panel to the card base.
30. Stamp the second Courage & Faith sentiment on the inside sentiment panel in Night of Navy ink.
31. Stamp the detailed side of the small turtle using Calypso Coral ink.
32. Clean the stamp and turn it to the other side.
33. Using Calypso Coral ink, stamp off twice then position the stamp background over the detailed stamp.
34. Adhere the sentiment panel to the card base with Stampin' Seal.
35. Glue the DSP to the envelope flap and trim to size with paper snips.
36. With the large Starfish, inked with Calypso Coral, stamp three times on the envelope front without reinking.
37. Tag me at #stampwithnel when you post your finished card 😊
