Cutting Instructions:

Very Vanilla

2-3/4" x 5-1/4" inside sentiment

Scrap for circle diecut

Scrap for stamping large vase

Pecan Pie

5-1/2" x 8-1/2" scored at 1-1/4" and

4-1/4" card base

Scrap for die cut

Pebbled Path

Scrap for diecut

Distressed Gold Specialty Paper

Scrap for die cut handle

Earthen Elegance DSP

Pattern 1: 2-3/4" x 5-1/4" (2 pcs)

Pattern 2: 1" x 5-1/2" (2 pcs)

Scrap for die cut

2-1/4" x 6" envelope flap

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the card base with a bone folder, folding the 1-1/4" open.
2. Swipe a Very Vanilla scrap with the embossing buddy.
3. Stamp the tall vase on a scrap of Very Vanilla with Versamark ink.
4. Sprinkle with Heat & Stick powder and use your heat tool to melt the powder just like heat embossing.
5. TURN OFF ALL FANS and close the windows 😊 and then open the Gilded Leafing. It's light and will expand, so open the jar slowly.
6. Press Gilded Leafing all over the vase with your fingers, then use a sponge dauber or piece of crafting sponge to lightly rub off the excess Gilded Leafing.

7. Die cut the following using the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine:
 - a. Gilded Leafing cover vase
 - b. Distressed Gold Specialty Paper vase handles
 - c. Pebbled Path large leaf frond
 - d. Pecan Pie large leaf frond
 - e. DSP large leaf frond
 - f. Everyday Essentials or other small (approximately 2") circle for focal point base
 - g. Very Vanilla inside sentiment – emboss the texture pattern at the bottom of the panel.
8. With your adhesive of choice, adhere the narrow pattern 2 DSP panels to the front panel and the right side of the inside card base. This piece of DSP fits from top to bottom with a small margin on either side.
9. Adhere the pattern 1 DSP pieces to the front panel and the inside front panel with your adhesive of choice. These panels will have a margin all the way around.
10. Build your focal point using the tall vase, vase handle and the three large leaves. Adhere the leaves to the back of the vase with your adhesive of choice.
11. Adhere the completed focal point to the 2" circle with adhesive.
12. Adhere the focal point to the front card fold with adhesive. I adhered the circle and the back leaves to the panel.
13. Add three embellishments to the front.
14. Stamp your sentiment at the top of the Very Vanilla sentiment panel with Pebbled Path ink and add the panel to the card base with your adhesive of choice. I prefer Stampin' Seal here.
15. Add the DSP to the envelope flap with adhesive.
16. Stamp the front of the envelope with the small vase using Pebbled Path ink stamped off twice.
17. Use a sticky note to cover the top of the vase then stamp the grass stalks using Pecan Pie ink stamped off once.
18. Tag me at #stampwithnel when you post your finished card 😊
