Cutting Instructions - Pinwheel

Basic White

4" x 5-1/4" inside sentiment
Scrap for die cutting

Berry Burst

5-1/2" x 8-1/2" scored at 4-1/4" cardbase
4" x 5-1/4" front panel

Daffodil Delight

2-5/8" x 2-5/8" (x 2)

Just Kiddin' Designer Series Paper

1-1/4" x 1-1/4" – 4 pcs pattern 1
1-1/4" x 1-1/4" – 4 pcs pattern 2
1/2" x 4" for inside sentiment panel
2-1/4" x 6" envelope flap
Scrap for die cut

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the card base with a bone folder.
2. Using grid paper, line up one Daffodil Delight square so it is straight horizontally, then line up the second vertically aligned with the points straight on the gridlines.
3. Adhere the two squares together as shown using your adhesive of choice.
4. Start with a 1-1/4" pattern 1 square and add a dot of liquid glue to the upper right corner only.
5. Adhere the square to the Daffodil Delight base leaving a small margin at the edge.
6. Using liquid glue, adhere DSP pattern 2 to the pinwheel base overlapping the first piece.
7. With liquid glue, adhere DSP pattern 1 to the pinwheel base overlapping the second piece.

8. Continue adding 1-1/4" squares around the pinwheel, alternating patterns until you reach piece 8.
9. Add liquid glue to the back of the 8th 1-1/4" square and slide it under piece one while adhering it to the pinwheel base.
10. Add liquid glue to the underside of piece 1 and adhere over piece 8.
11. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the pinwheel and adhere to the Berry Burst front panel.
12. Stamp the sentiment on Basic White cardstock with Berry Burst ink and diecut the sentiment banner.
13. Diecut a piece of Just Kiddin' DSP using the sentiment banner die.
14. Adhere the white sentiment banner to the DSP banner with adhesive, then adhere to the front of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
15. Adhere the front panel to the cardbase with adhesive.
16. Add five Rhinestone Basic Jewels to the front of the card.
17. Stamp the second sentiment on the inside panel.
18. Adhere the 1/2" strip of DSP to the sentiment panel.
19. Adhere the sentiment panel to the cardbase with adhesive.
20. Adhere the DSP to the envelope flap with adhesive.
21. Decorate the front of the envelope as desired.
22. Tag me at #stampwithnel when you post your finished card 😊

Basic White

4" x 5-1/4" inside sentiment

2023-2025 Luster Specialty Paper

5" x 5-1/2" scored at 4-1/4 on the 5" side

Earthen Elegance Designer Series Paper

4-1/4" x 5-1/2"

Distressed Gold Specialty Paper

2-1/4" x 6" for envelope flap

1/2" x 5-1/4" for inside panel

Natural 1/4" Wavy Trim

Approximately 6-1/2"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the card base with a bone folder.
2. Add the trim to the 3/4" book fold edge adhering the edges on the underside with Stampin' Seal+
3. Add adhesive to the underside of the fold and adhere to the Earthen Elegance Designer Series Paper lining up all the edges with the card base.

4. Use the hexagon punch to punch an opening in the DSP on the lower right of the front of the card.
5. Add the Basic White panel to the inside of the card for spacing.
6. Close the front of the card and stamp the sentiment on the basic white panel using the hexagon punched opening for spacing.
7. Adhere the sentiment panel to the card base with adhesive.
8. Close the card and add 2023-2025 In Color Dots to the front of the card and the sentiment
9. Tag me at #stampwithnel when you post your finished card 😊

Cutting Instructions – Faux Book fold with Focal Image

Earthen Elegance Designer Series Paper

4-1/4" x 5-1/2"

Basic White

4" x 5-1/4" inside sentiment

2023-2025 Luster Specialty Paper

Copper Clay: 5" x 5-1/2" scored at 4-1/4 on the 5" side

Scraps of Wild Wheat, Copper Clay, Pebbled Path and Boho Blue for die cuts

Silver-Threaded Trim

2 lengths long enough to wrap around the book fold flap twice and tie a bow. My pieces were 36" long which was a bit excessive 😊

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the card base with a bone folder.
2. Wrap trim around the book fold edge twice and tie a bow. Trim tails.
3. Line the DSP up with the card base and adhere the book fold edge to the DSP with you adhesive of choice.
4. Using the Mini Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine, die cut:
 - a. 2nd largest Radiating Stitches rectangle in Copper Clay Luster
 - b. Large leaf in Pebbled Path Luster
 - c. Smaller leaf fronds in Copper Clay and Boho Blue
 - d. Twig in Wild Wheat
 - e. Vase handles in Pebbled Path
 - f. Vase in Boho Blue, then emboss with textured die.
5. Create the focal image on the Radiating Stitches panel.
6. Adhere the focal image to the front of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals
7. Stamp the sentiment on DSP and die cut with sentiment banner.
8. Adhere the sentiment to the front of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.

9. Add three Copper Clay sequins to the front of the card.
10. Stamp the pampas grass on the inside panel with Copper Clay ink.
11. Adhere the sentiment panel to the card base with adhesive.
12. Add Earthen Elegance DSP to the envelope flap with adhesive.
13. Stamp the small vase on the front of the envelope.
14. Cover the vase with a sticky note and stamp the thin leaves with Pebbled Path ink stamped off once, then stamp the thinner twigs with Pebbled Path ink, stamped off once.
15. Tag me at #stampwithnel when you post your finished card 😊
