Cutting Instructions

Basic Beige Cardstock

4-1/4" x 11" scored at 5-1/2" for cardbase 4" x 5-1/4" inside panel 3-1/4" x 3-1/4" scrap for die cutting

Crumb Cake Cardstock

4" x 5-1/4" front panel 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" for die cut sand dollar

Basic White Cardstock

Scrap for die cutting

Azure Afternoon Cardstock

1-1/2" x 5" banner strip


Calypso Coral

Scrap for die cutting large and small star fish 4" x 5-1/4" gutted

Instructions

- 1. Cut, fold and burnish the Basic Beige card base.
- 2. Dry emboss the Crumb Cake Cardstock and adhere to the card front.
- 3. Cut the banner tails on both ends of the Azure Afternoon 1-1/2" x 5" strip. Adhere to the Crumb Cake panel with adhesive.
- 4. Die cut:
 - a. large and small star fish from Calypso Coral Cardstock
 - b. large and small coral from Basic White Cardstock
 - c. Sand dollar using the Hybrid Seaside Wishes Embossing Folder
 - d. 2-7/8" Deckled Circle (6th from center) in Basic Beige
- 5. Add Crumb Cake ink to the sand dollar using a blending brush.
- 6. Use the Deckled Circle as a base and build the focal point. I cut the larger coral piece in half before tucking and adhering it behind the star fish and the sand dollar.
- 7. Adhere the focal point to the front of the card, over the banner strip, with your favorite adhesive.
- 8. I've heard the Makers mention "gutting" a piece of paper. Basically we're going to cut the center out of the 4" x 5-1/4" Calypso Coral pattern using the trimmer.
- 9. Place the short end of the Calypso Coral panel against the top of the trimmer, line up the right edge of the panel at the $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the right side of the trimmer.
- 10. Set the blade in $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge and cut to the 5" mark.
- 11. Turn the panel to the left, line the long edge at the top and the right edge $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the right side of the trimmer and cut from $\frac{1}{4}$ " in to 3-3/4".
- 12. Turn the panel again, line up the right edge at $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the right side of the trimmer. Set the blade in $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge and cut from $\frac{1}{4}$ " to 5".
- 13. Turn the panel one final time, line up the edge at $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the right side of the trimmer and insert the blade $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge and cut to the 3-3/4" mark.
- 14. It should look like this:



where the outside edges are all $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide and the center (gray area) is cut out.

- 15. Adhere the Calypso Coral frame to the Basic Beige with adhesive.
- 16. Stamp the sentiment with Crumb Cake ink and the sea glass with Azure Afternoon ink
- 17. Tag me at #stampwithnel when you finish your card. 😊
