Cutting Instructions

Night of Navy Cardstock

5-5/8" x 6-5/8" box base scored as indicated 3/4" x 3/4" flag canton

Cherry Cobbler Cardstock

1-1/2" x 2" flag base

Basic White Cardstock

1/4" x 2" (3 pcs) flag field 3-1/2" x 1-3/4" inside panel

Neutrals 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper – Night of Navy

3-1/2" x 1-3/4" box top (2 pieces if you wish to decorate top and bottom)

Regals 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper – Cherry Cobbler

1-3/4" x 5/8" (2 pcs) 3-1/2" x 5/8" (2 pcs)

Instructions

- 1. Score, fold and burnish card base.
- 2. Score the card base with the short end on top at 7/8" and 4-3/4".
- 3. Score the card base with the long end on top at 7/8", 2-7/8", 3-3/4", 5-3/4".
- 4. Fold and burnish all score lines with a bone folder to define them.
- 5. With the short end at the top, cut out the two side squares.
- 6. Cut the next two score lines and miter the edges. Do the same on the other side of the box.
- 7. At the bottom, snip the left and right corner squares on the inside score line and miter slightly.
- 8. Add two small pieces of Tear and Tape to the small squares and burnish with the bone folder.
- 9. Starting at the bottom of the box, fold the small squares toward the center and adhere to the long middle section.
- 10. Fold the next two small squares towards the box base and adhere to the short sides
- 11. To get the side pieces to fit, you will need to miter them more than the other sections.
- 12. Once the side pieces are in the box, the lid is naturally closed with a front lip.
- 13. Decorate the top (and bottom if desired) with Night of Navy DSP.
- 14. Decorate the short and long side pieces with the corresponding DSP pieces.
- 15. Snip the top of the flag piece to form a tag. Use your grid lines to make the snips equal.
- 16. Add the canton to the Cherry Cobbler base. Use a white gel pen (Amazon) or white embellishments in the canton for stars.
- 17. Add the ¼" white stripes to the field starting ¼" from the top. You will add 1 short and 3 long Basic White Stripes.
- 18. Stamp the inside panel all over with the Iconic Imagery texture stamp using Daffodil Delight Ink. Turn the paper to vary the stamp placement.
- 19. Stamp the sentiment using Night of Navy Ink in the center of the panel.
- 20. With Cherry Cobbler Ink, stamp the star image in several places on the inside panel.
- 21. Adhere the inside panel to the inside box top with adhesive.
- 22. Insert your treat and close the box.
- 23. Use a small (1/8") hole punch or the Take Your Pick tool to poke a hole in the tag.
- 24. Thread Iridescent ½" Striped Trim through the flag tag hole and tie in a bow around the closed box.
- 25. Trim ribbon tails.
- 26. Add three Rhinestone Basic Jewels to the box front.
- 27. Tag me at #stampwithnel when you make this card. I would love to see your card.
